The I AM MIMe Experience (IAME), announces the ***I AM MIMe Experience Scholarship Award Program***. Under the Program, two (2) scholarships will be awarded to seniors attending a high school within the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the greater community and/or church in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must plan to attend a 2 or 4-year college or technical school.
- * Applicants must have a performing arts background, which include mime, drama, music, dance, etc.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid ***in August 2019 for the first semester of the student's first year directly to the college*** and not to the student. It is the student's responsibility to submit to the committee at that time an invoice for first semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor and/or Community Leader on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program.
- * Application deadline is **June 15, 2019 by 4:00 p.m.** Late applications are not accepted.
